

Wolverine Building Group Donates \$2,000 to Associated Construction Students

The Ferris State University Associated Construction Students received a \$2,000 donation from the Wolverine Building Group, of Grand Rapids, to purchase equipment needed to help serve the local community.

The donation from the Wolverine Building Group was pursued by Ferris senior Patrick Kelly, who is majoring in Construction Management. The money will aid the student group in purchasing necessary hand tools that will be used by the group for community service projects.
