Trails Await the Warm Seasons

Grand Rapids, MI; Owosso, MI (March 27, 2009) – Signs of spring fever are already starting to arise while City Parks and Recreation Departments prepare for the upcoming warm seasons.

Wolverine recently completed the addition to the Meijer Trails system in Grand Rapids. The new trail is accessed from Millennium Park and weaves along the Grand River, through thriving wetlands, and over rehabilitated railroad trestles. About 4 miles long the trails are truly a remarkable addition to the Kent County Trail system and will be a great asset to those who can't wait to explore the open air this summer.

Wolverine is currently heading another trail in downtown Owosso. Along the Shiawassee River a 900 foot long elevated wooden boardwalk will be installed from Washington Street to Oakwood. A historic wrought iron bridge will also be renovated into a pedestrian crossing as the trail connects to the Harmon Partridge Park.

According to Project Manager Brandon Hartel, "This is a unique project and is one that is taking us out of our typical realm of expertise. We are broadening our work horizons and hope that this will bring many years of enjoyment to the City of Owosso."
