TRANSFORMING THE HIDDEN JEWEL

Grand Haven, MI (April 6, 2009) Wolverine Building is please to announce the beginning of renovations at Covenant Life Church located on 101 Columbus in Grand Haven. Unlike many churches, Covenant Life members gather in a factory building originally constructed in the early 1900's. They purchased a portion of the Story & Clark Piano factory campus for their worship space in 1995, and have been growing ever since.

They have been slowly renovating portions of the three story facility as their outreach program grows, and are now preparing to open a youth program center on their second floor. This renovated space will house their Middle and High School Ministry programs, as well as providing a youth recreation area. The Church's volunteer group is even taking an active roll during construction. Working closely with Craig Architects Wolverine will complete Phase I of the renovation of the 15,500 square feet of space. This exciting adaptive reuse of a truly unique building will be completed mid June of this year.

Wolverine's Project Manager, Dulane Coval, notes the rewards of this project far outweigh the challenges. He reports, "I have been involved with this group's Building Committee for over 10 years, and have come to truly appreciate the visionaries that are steering this group. Their mantra in renovating this facility has been 'Calvinistic Elegance' in everything they do, and they have been very successful in achieving that goal. Over the years, I have witnessed them transforming a vacant hulk into one of the Lakeshore's hidden jewels, and am thrilled to be a part of it!"
