Construction Underway for The Lodges of East Lansing

July 23, 2010 (East Lansing, MI) – Set to become one of the most notable addresses near Michigan State University, The Lodges of East Lansing project has broken ground on the 16 acre Student Housing Project at 2700 Hannah Blvd in East Lansing, MI. The 683-bed development is the vision of nationally renowned firm Capstone Development Corp., offering exceptional student living unmatched by any other near campus.

The Lodges will offer a host of amenities to enhance the student living experience. The Irish-pub style clubhouse is designed to maximize social gatherings with fire places, big screen TVs, and patio grills. Residents will have access to a 24-hour fitness center, heated outdoor pool, hot tub, sauna, and tanning beds for relaxation. For the competitive crowd there will be an on-site volleyball court, billiard tables, ping pong, bocce ball, and an ice-skating rink during the winter.

Wolverine Building Group leads the construction on the 300,000 square foot development. Pouring foundations began last week. The project includes six three-story buildings and a 5,000 square foot community club house. Dungan Nequette Architects of Alabama designed The Lodges to compliment the surrounding East Lansing architecture including classic masonry, high pitched roofs, and dark wood framing. The architecture is also an efficient design allowing Wolverine to put the project on a fast track schedule and make effective use of materials during construction.

The Lodges of East Lansing is set to complete in July 2011 before the MSU fall semester begins.

According to Wolverine Vice President, Curt Mulder, “Capstone Development has always strived to be a company that continually re-defines student housing. The Lodges of East Lansing will be no different where everything from the architecture, clubhouse amenities and even how the management staff greets potential clients is re-defined.
