**Expansion Starts on East Grand Rapids' DPW Facility**

July 27, 2010 (Grand Rapids, MI) – Wolverine Building is proud to begin construction on the East Grand Rapids Department of Public Work facility off Reeds Lake Blvd. The Design/Build project will include a 6,000 square foot addition as well as the renovation to the existing 17,200 square feet of space.

Designed by Wolverine's in-house architect, Gordon Jendritz, the DPW expansion will allow for a more efficient storage space for the city's public vehicles and machinery. The vehicle maintenance area and office space will also be relocated and updated to serve the growing needs of the department. The project is budgeted at \$1.3 Million and is estimated to complete by January 2011.
