Public Works Complex Completed Ahead of Schedule and Under Budget

January, 14 2011 (East Grand Rapids, MI) – Wolverine Building Group is proud to announce the completion of the new East Grand Rapids Public Works Complex located off of Reeds Lake Blvd. The \$1.2 million project included an extensive renovation to the existing 17,200 square foot building as well as a 6,000 square foot addition.

Wolverine’s team was able to cut the project schedule in half by coordinating with city workers to move them into temporary office space on site during construction. Working on the unoccupied building allowed Wolverine to expedite construction and finish the project months ahead of the original completion date of June 2011. In turn, the early completion date also helped the city spend less of their allocated budget for the project.

The city employees 16 people in the public works department who are currently moving into the new complex this week. The renovated portion of the building houses a wood shop, parts storage, and a garage to store city maintenance vehicles such as snowplows, sweepers, and dump trucks. The addition includes the city’s new vehicle service center, a mezzanine for storage, office area, sleeping accommodations for third shift employees, showering facilities, and a full kitchen.

Wolverine is also beginning renovation work on the city’s salt storage facility.
