### **New Social Security Administrative Building in downtown Muskegon**

November 28, 2011 (Muskegon, MI) – New construction is planned for downtown Muskegon at 340 Morris Avenue. This week Wolverine Building Group will be breaking ground on a new federal office building for the Social Security Administration

The 11,000 square foot project will be built on a reclaimed contaminated site, which sat as an unused parking lot from an old MichCon plant for many years. Muskegon officials and city supporters are pleased to bring in a new building to Morris Avenue, projecting it as a catalyst toward the movement to redevelop the downtown area, and spur future growth.

The development team includes developer Bob Dykstra, architect, Landmark Design Group, and general contractor, Wolverine Building Group. The single story steel framed, brick veneer building will include 36 work stations. Project costs are expected to reach \$1.4 Million.

Move in is expected for May 2012.
